Effective Thursday, March 17, 2022 face coverings will be optional for all employees and members of the public who enter a County owned or leased facility, except for The Aroostook County Jail. Face coverings are currently required at the Aroostook County Jail.

- Remote meetings continue to be encouraged.
- Maximum capacity limits remain unchanged.
- Quarantine and isolation protocols remain in place.
